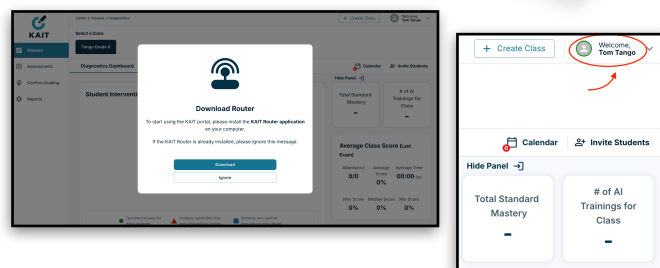




STEP ONE:

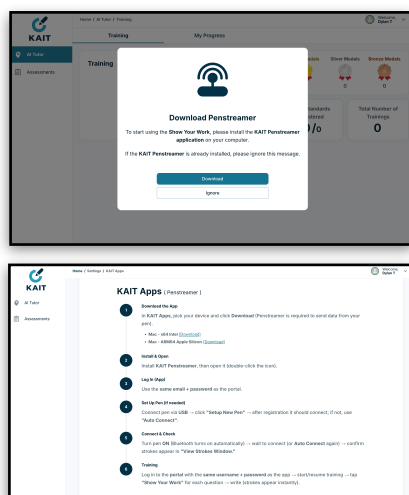
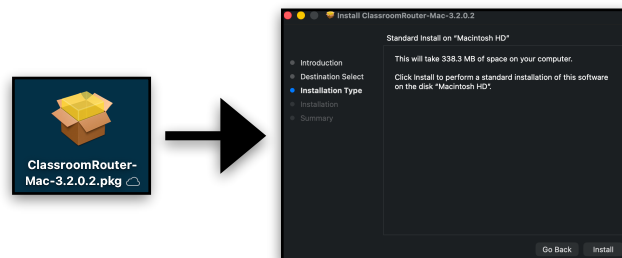
Login to your teacher account from the login page at kailsolutions.com. You will be automatically prompted to install the classroom router upon your initial login. You can find this page by clicking the user name in the upper right hand corner and then selecting “Kait Apps”.



STEP TWO:

Our system will register what your operating software is, and provide the corresponding link to download (Mac vs. PC).

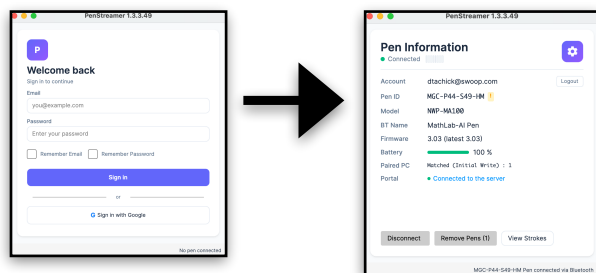
Download the installer and double click. Proceed through the prompts until “Install” appears.



MAC USERS: X64 intel is for models 2019 and older.
ARM64 Apple Silicon is 2020 and onwards.

PENSTREAMER: The application is found in KAIT apps via your student accounts. Your student will be prompted upon initial login to install the Penstreamer. Please guide your students through the installation, just as you did to install the Classroom Router.

If the teacher would like access to the penstreamer, please login to one of your student accounts using “123456” as the password before you distribute access to your class. Please remind your students to create their own custom password.

CONNECTING YOUR PEN: Once Penstreamer is installed, open and login with your student account. Connect your pen to your computer directly via USB-C and select “Set Up New Pen”. You will see a confirmation that the Pen has been synced. Now please select “AutoConnect” to finish establishing the connection. Your student is now ready for our live feedback during trainings!

NOTE: Your computer may flag our software for precautionary measures as unrecognized developers:

MAC USERS: Open “System Settings” and then scroll down to find “Privacy and Security”. At the bottom of that page, you will find “Allow Applications from” and there you will see a notice to grant permission to install anyway.

PC USERS: If Windows displays a security warning, click “More info” on the warning screen. Then click “Run anyway” to allow the software to install.
